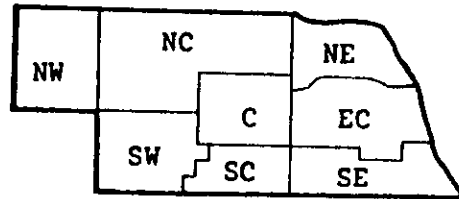

LEADING WHEAT VARIETY IS CENTURK

Centurk held the lead as the top ranking variety of wheat planted with 31.0%, or approximately 908,000 acres. Scout 66 retained second place with 20.3% as compared to 19.4% in 1973. Lancer remained third as a leading variety with 381,000 acres or 13.0% of the acreage planted. Other leading varieties were Scout and Warrior with 9.9 and 9.5%, or 468,000 acres. Gage and Trapper were again less popular than in the past with 4.9% and 3.3%, respectively. Scoutland, one of the newer varieties, advanced to 3.2% of the acreage planted compared with 1.6% for last year.

Centurk was the leading variety in five of the crop reporting districts with percentages as follows: Northwest, 40.1; Northeast, 28.6; Central, 35.2; East Central, 30.8; and Southeast, 25.4. In the Southwest District, Warrior took the lead with 27.7% with Centurk in second place with 23.9%. Scout 66 was the dominant variety in the South Central District with 31.9% followed by Scout with 26.4. It was also popular in the Southeast District with 23.7%. Gage took second place as the most popular variety in the Northeast and East Central and third place in the Southeast District.
