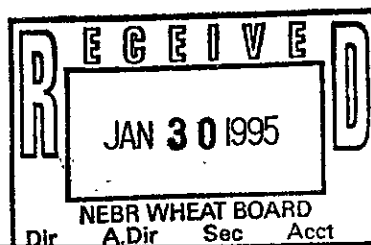

## ARAPAHOE MOST POPULAR VARIETY PLANTED FOR 1995

### Highlights

For the third year in a row, Arapahoe was the most popular winter wheat variety sown for the 1995 crop with 33.6% of Nebraska's acreage. Centura remained in second place with 8.0% and Thunderbird remained in third place with 7.8%. Karl, at 6.9%, and Vista, at 4.6%, pushed Siouxland and Redland out of the top five to take over fourth and fifth places, respectively.

Arapahoe remained the most popular variety in all Agricultural Statistics Districts, except the Northeast and Southeast. Karl became the leading variety in the Southeast. Karl tied Tomahawk for the top spot in the Northeast and moved up to second place in the South Central. Vista also made a large jump to second in the North Central District.

### Data Source

The wheat variety data was provided through the response of many Nebraska wheat producers in our annual Fall Acreage and Production Survey. The wheat variety survey summary included 1,310 reports representing about fourteen percent of the State's total planted acreage estimate.

This wheat variety survey summary was made possible with Nebraska producer wheat check off funds provided by the Nebraska Wheat Board.
