

USDA Crop Progress Report for the week ending June 5th, 2024

Winter wheat condition rated 1% very poor, 4% poor, 27% fair, 53% good and 15% excellent. Winter wheat headed was 72% above the 5-year average of 55%. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 3% very short, 11% short, 74% adequate and 12% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 4% very short, 17% short, 70% adequate and 9% surplus.

Northern Panhandle

Wheat in the northern panhandle is over 50% headed and looking good. Disease levels remain low and unproblematic. There has been 1/2 inch of rain over the last week. A local producer predicts to have an above average wheat crop this harvest.

Southern Panhandle

Last week brought a bit of moisture and hail to the southern panhandle. A local producer stated that some of his fields had hail damage across the area. Pests and diseases have posed no threat at this time. The producer also stated that more rain is needed.

Southwest

Southwestern Nebraska received around an inch of rain over the last week. There have been no disease or pests spotted, but as one local producer stated, preventive measures have been taken by applying fungicides. Despite the lack of ample rain, the wheat crop is predicted to be average this year.

Southcentral

According to a local producer, the southcentral region has dry subsoil and rain is needed. Disease levels are low, with stripe rust remaining to be a potential threat. Wheat is finishing up heading and flowering is increasing.
