

# Nebraska Wheat Crop Report

## June 14, 2024



### USDA Crop Progress Report for the week ending June 12th, 2024

Winter wheat condition rated 3% very poor, 7% poor, 18% fair, 40% good and 32% excellent. Winter wheat headed was 93% above the 5-year average of 77%. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 2% very short, 16% short, 71% adequate and 11% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 4% very short, 18% short, 69% adequate and 9% surplus.

#### Northern Panhandle

There has been a 1/4 inch of rain over the last week in the northern panhandle. According to a local producer, stripe rust has been seen scattered throughout fields in the area. For the most part, the wheat in the northern panhandle looks good, but more moisture is always needed.

#### Southern Panhandle

The southern panhandle has been dry and rain is needed. According to a local producer, there have been active signs of leaf streak mosaic in the area that is predicted to cause an early harvest in some areas. Overall, the wheat in this region looks pretty good with harvest approaching quickly.

#### Southwest

Southwestern Nebraska received little moisture over the last week. There has been disease spotted in a few fields, but does not raise a huge concern at this time. Despite the lack of ample rain over the last few weeks, the wheat crop is predicted to be average this harvest season.

#### Southcentral

Wheat is slowly moving into the flowering stage across the area. A local producer states this region has dry subsoil and is in need of more rain. Disease levels remain low, with stripe rust being a potential threat in some areas.

#### Southeast

The southeast region received around a 1/2 inch of rain throughout the last week. There has been stripe rust spotted across the area, but is not a huge concern at this time. According to a local producer, wheat is over 50% filled and in the melt/soft dough stage.
