USDA Crop Progress Report for the week ending June 26th, 2024

Winter wheat condition rated 1% very poor, 4% poor, 26% fair, 50% good and 19% excellent. Winter wheat headed was 100% above the 5-year average of 96%. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 2% very short, 15% short, 66% adequate and 17% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 2% very short, 19% short, 67% adequate and 12% surplus. 2% of the Nebraska wheat crop is harvested thus far.

Northern Panhandle

The northern panhandle received between a 1/2 to 1 inch of rain the past week. According to a local producer, farmers are gearing up for harvest and will be in full swing in a couple of weeks. The wheat is starting to turn with harvest being about a month out.
