



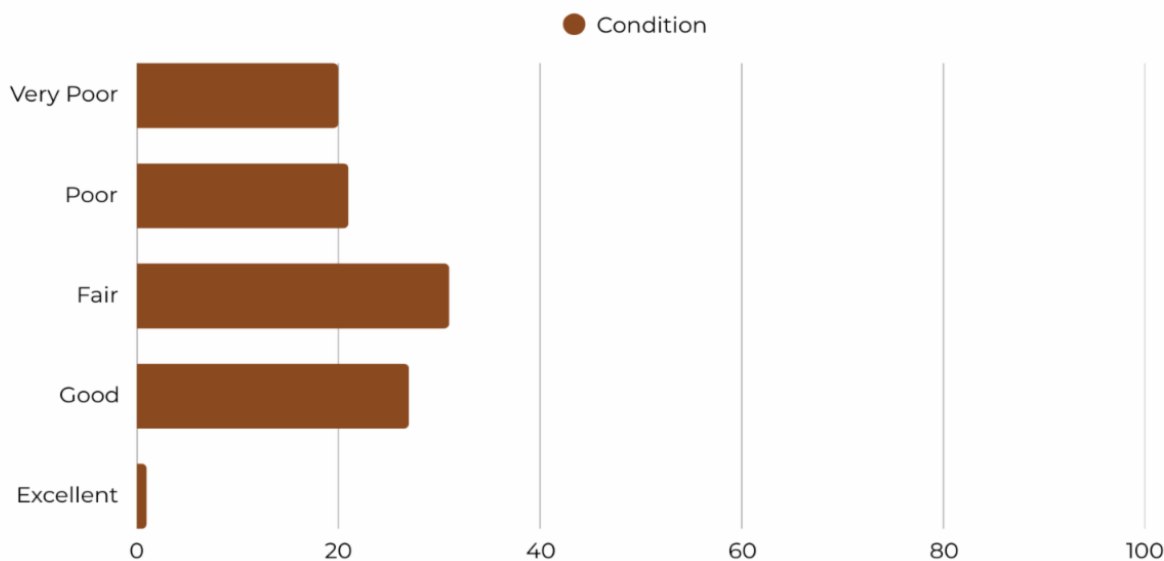
Nebraska Wheat Crop Report

District 5 Report

District 5 received much-needed precipitation over the past week, with rainfall totals ranging from 0.10 to 1 inch across the area. Scattered hail events were reported, though no significant damage has been noted. While the recent moisture was welcome, additional rainfall is still critically needed across the state due to the ongoing dry conditions throughout the growing season, which may impact wheat yields this harvest season.

Wheat Conditions

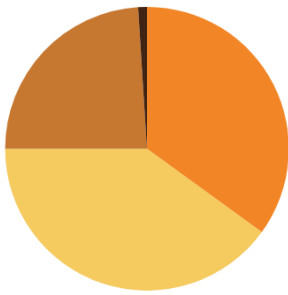


Moisture Conditions

Topsoil Moisture

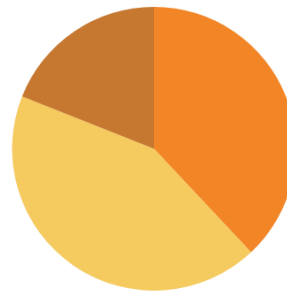
Very Short Short Adequate Surplus

- Surplus = 1%

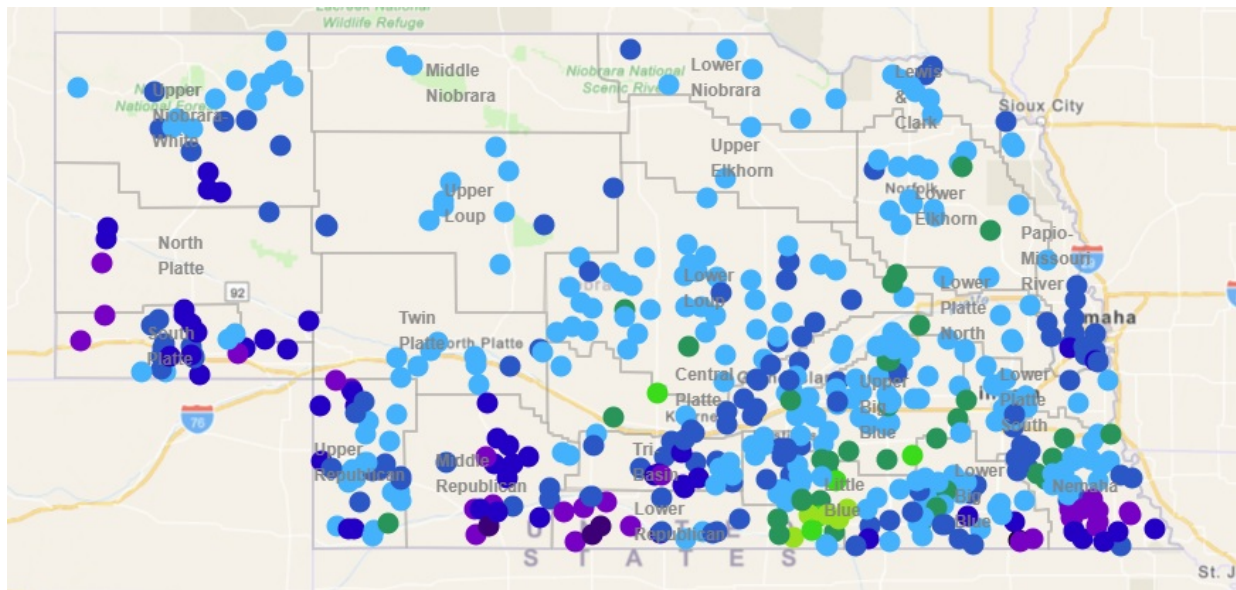
Subsoil Moisture
