



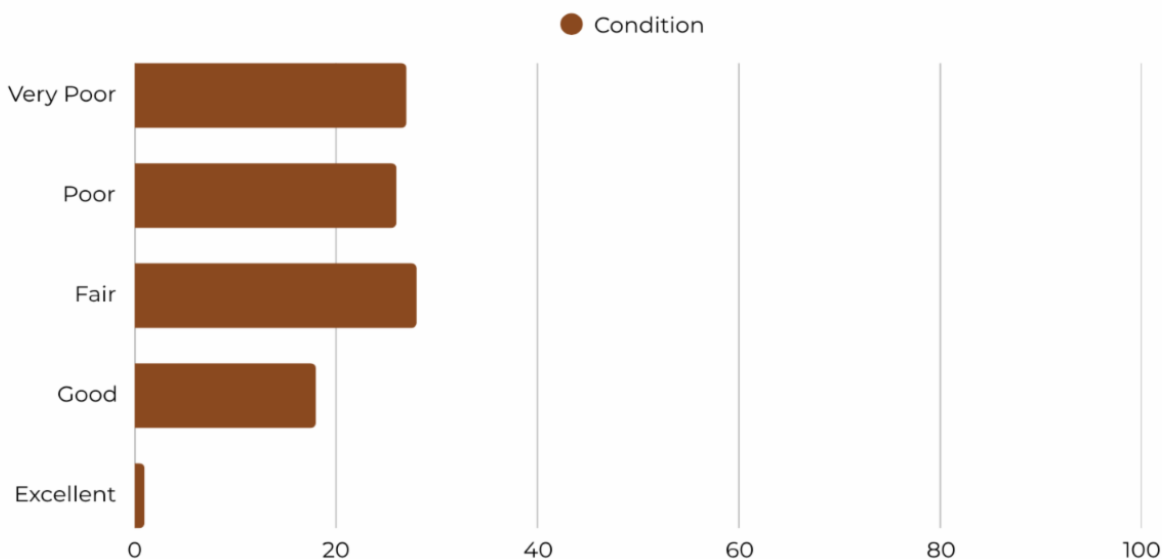
## Nebraska Wheat Crop Report

Week of: May 26, 2025

### District 4 Report

In District 4, the wheat crop has progressed into the filling to milk stage, with overall stand conditions ranging from fair to good. While some fields are performing well, others remain below average. Precipitation over the past week has been scattered, with most areas receiving between 0.5 and 2 inches of moisture. Although strong storms have moved through the district, hail damage appears to be minimal; wind and tornadic activity have been more prominent. Drought conditions have taken a notable toll in certain areas, leading to a significant reduction in yield potential. Current projections estimate yields to range primarily between 35 and 45 bushels per acre, with isolated fields potentially reaching 60 bushels.

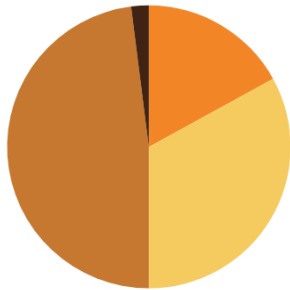

## Topsoil Moisture

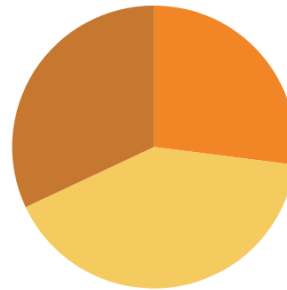
Very Short Short Adequate Surplus

- Surplus = 2%

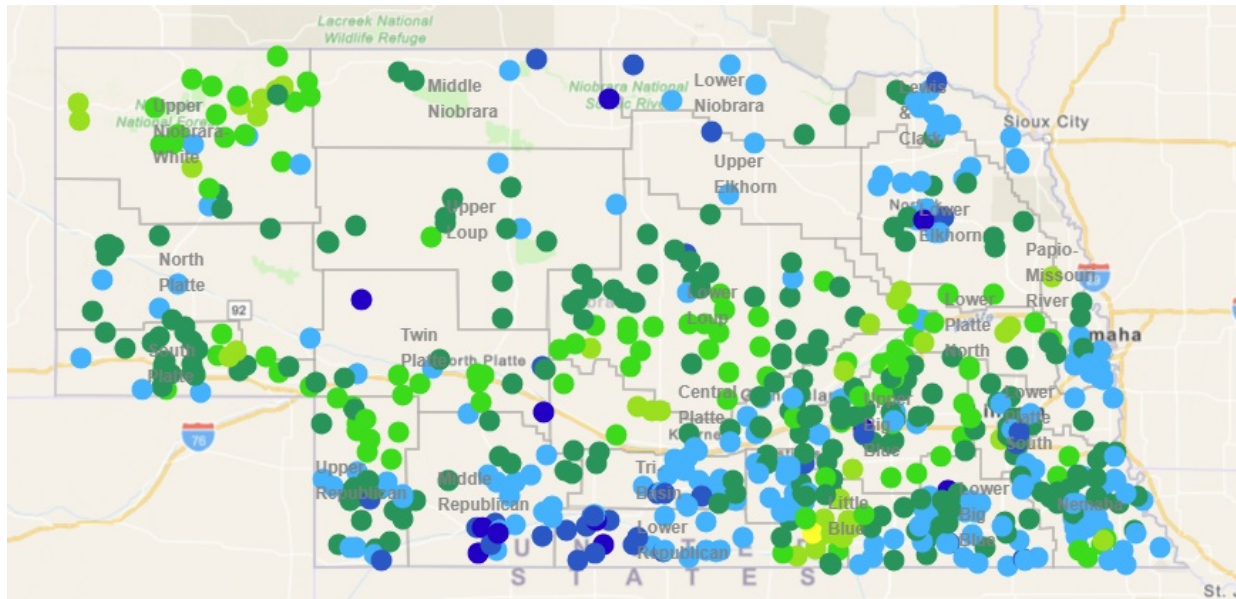
## Subsoil Moisture
