

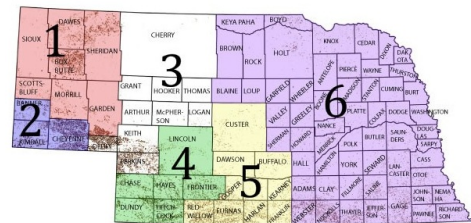


Nebraska Wheat Crop Report

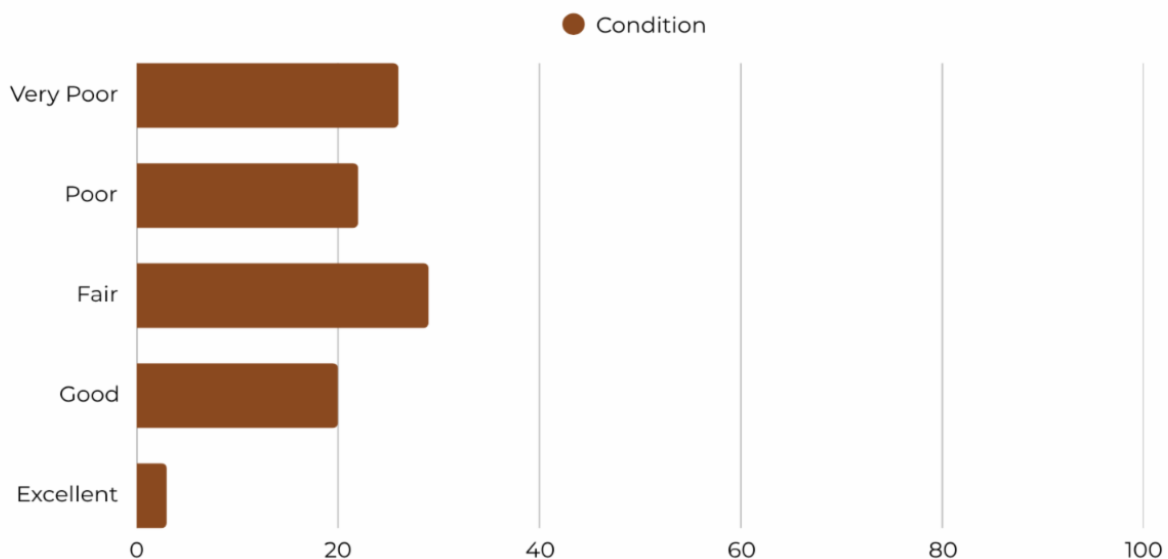
Week of: June 2, 2025

District 3 Report

Wheat development in District 3 continues, although field conditions vary across the region. Stands are generally thin, and field uniformity is limited, with uneven growth noted across much of the region. White caps have been observed in several areas, indicating crop stress caused by the lack of early-season moisture. However, the district has received much-needed precipitation over the past two weeks, totaling between 4 to 5 inches. Current yield estimates range from 40 to 50 bushels per acre in this area.



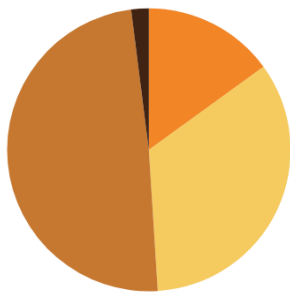
Wheat Conditions

Topsoil Moisture

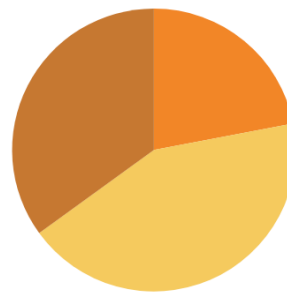
Very Short Short Adequate Surplus

- Surplus = 2%

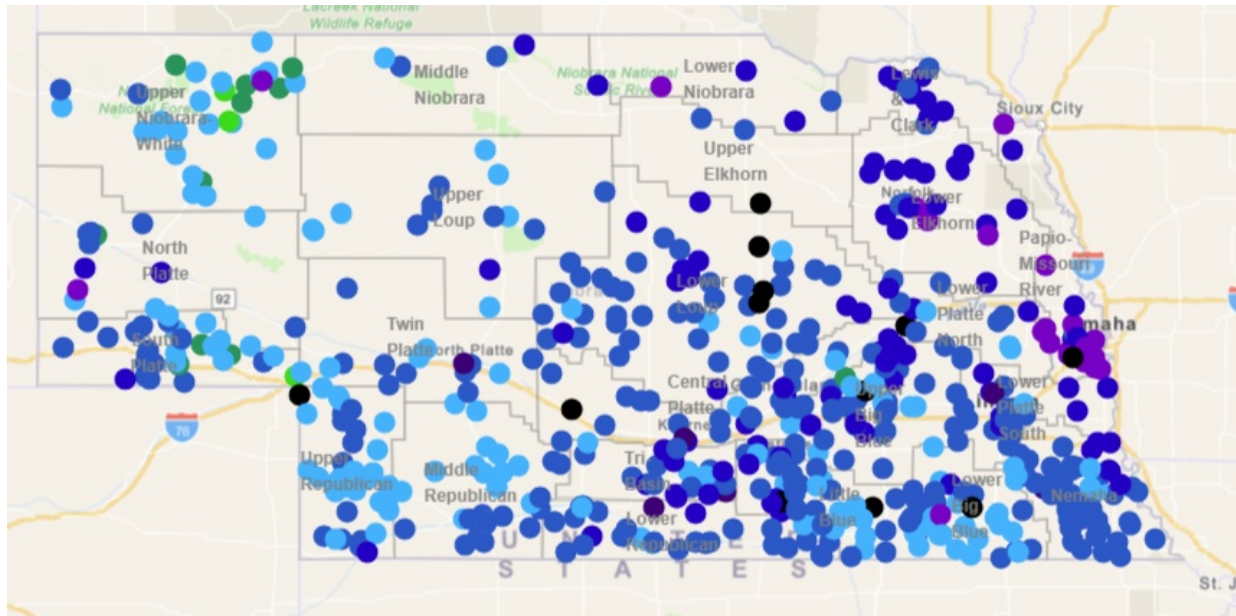
Subsoil Moisture
